

Policy on Curriculum Guidance

- To make sure all staff are inducted into how we work towards the curriculum (early learning goals)/EYFS.
- Activities are set out to help children progress in all areas of development.
- To ensure that all staff are informed of any changes in the curriculum.
- To ensure regular training meetings are held to ensure all staff understand the curriculum and are able to explain to parent/carers if need be.
- To have all curriculum plans displayed and up dated accordingly.
- To follow guidance of other outside agencies regarding the curriculum. E.g. early year's unit, **OFSTED** – National Standards etc.
- To be aware of how we can adapt all curriculum activities, into learning experiences.
- To make sure all activities are set up in an interesting way and can be adapted to various age ranges.
- To make sure you are evaluating all activities honestly.
- To inform parents/carers of any changes regarding the curriculum.
- To ensure that all planning takes into account any special needs children.
- To ensure that there is a mixture of adult led and child led activities.
- Activities are provided in an interesting and stimulating way.
- To cover all seven learning areas on a day to day basis.
- To be aware of all seven learning areas and the strands of each area and intentions of each area.
- To be aware of and carry out all long, medium and short term planning.
- To incorporate child observation into our planning.
